Condition Expectations for Integral Cove

Integral Cove is a hand-built base that integrates the floor and the wall to create a seamless 'bathtub' effect. To deliver BEST WORK for the project, we need a smooth, sound, and solid substrate.



Drywall. Smooth and even. No gaps larger than 1/2".



FRP Panels. Installed to the bottom of drywall. Flat and secured, not wavy, cracked, or uneven.



CMU Block. Clean, with no glue or residue.

Below are examples of walls **NOT** ready to build integral cove.



Finish. DCD will build the base and finish with a paintable caulking compound at the top. It is to be expected that some paint/drywall will chip at the top of the cove base. The owner or General Contractor will be responsible for painting after the epoxy floor installation.
